Parking Enforcement

Effective February 1st, 2021, no street parking from 2:00 AM to 5:00 AM will be allowed.

Residents are reminded that street parking will once again be prohibited overnight in The Summit unless the vehicle displays auest parking pass available only from The Management Trust. The Association's security will patrol place warning notices on vehicles parked overnight and will record the license number of illegally parked vehicles. After two warnings, ticketed vehicles may be towed without further notice. Retrieving a towed vehicle is both costly and Please inconvenient. remember that parking on Hathaway Court is prohibited

unless the vehicle displays a Summit resident vehicle sticker or One-Day Parking Pass, both available from The Management Trust. This rule was established to keep people living outside The Summit from parking on Hathaway in order to gain free access to the Folsom Lake State Recreation Area. This problem occurs most often on weekends.

If you still have holiday decorations up, please remove them and avoid receiving a courtesy notice from Management.

Everyone was sent a form to fill out with information for a new directory. Another updated form is attached to this newsletter. March 16 is the return date. If you do not return the form, any information we have on file for you will go into the new directory. Please include your email address and a contact number that will be logged into your file so you can receive any notices that are periodically sent without the association having to spend extra for a mailing.

Guests & Parties

Please be reminded that there are no resident gate codes for the Summit gates because of past issues with people posting the codes on the call boxes and in public places.

Guests:

- If you are planning on having a party or event, you can request a temporary gate code for the duration of your event.
- You need to contact Management to request a gate code at least 48 hours in advance.
- You may not post the code at either gate. Remind any real estate person that may be helping you to not do it, either.
- Your temporary code will be set prior to your event so that you can test it to ensure that the programming and gate system are working properly.
- You may not request the same code for multiple events in a row.
- You must confirm the code with Management before you give the code to your guests.
- Make sure to let your guests know that they have to press '#' before the code; otherwise the code will not work.
- You can utilize the call box to let each guest into the community if your name and phone number are programmed into the gate. To add your information, contact Management.
